33. Adjudication = process of determining the guilt or innocence of a defendant
34. Continuance = adjournment of scheduled case until a later date
35. Entrapment = defense that the individual was tempted/provoked by the police to commit a crime
36. Jurisdiction = the range of a court's authority
37. Plain view doctrine = officers may examine and seize, w/out a warrant evidence or contraband that is in open view
38. Direct evidence = eyewitness accounts
39. Real evidence = physical evidence, such as weapons, fingerprints, stolen property, etc...
40. Circumstantial evidence = is a fact that can be used to infer another fact
41. Direct evidence = based on a witness's personal knowledge or observation of that fact
42. Visible crime = "street crime", crime against a person or property
43. Subpoena = court request for the witness' presence at a specific date and time for testimony
44. Hearsay = unverified information heard or received from another
45. 6<sup>th</sup> Amendment = Right to Speedy & Public Trial
46. 6<sup>th</sup> Amendment = Right to a Impartial Jury
47. 6<sup>th</sup> Amendment = Right to Counsel
48. 6<sup>th</sup> Amendment = Right to be informed of the charges against you
49. 6<sup>th</sup> Amendment = Right to question and call witnesses
