

## Isley's Classroom Policies

Note: The teacher has the right to determine the severity of punishment based on the nature of the student behavior.

### Respect

- Raise your hand before talking
- No sleeping or head down on desk
- Physical or verbal abuse will not be tolerated
- Do not argue with others or the teacher
- Respect opinions that are different from your own

### Preparation

- Bring all class materials with you
- You will receive only ONE copy of class materials/assignments
- Paper and writing utensil is something you will need everyday
- Bring your textbook, will not allow you to share with other student
- Points can and will be deducted from classroom assignments/quizzes if becomes a habitual problem

### Absences/Tardy-Late Work

- I do not accept late work
- If you are in class, all assignments are expected to be completed and turned in during the appropriate time-Current Events are always expected at the beginning of class, along w/ majority of daily assignments. Any major paper, deadline is usually listed on the assignment sheet
- If you have an arranged absence-all work must be turned in before your absence, current events, homework assignments, completion of test or quiz, etc...
- My expectation: If you miss my class but arrive at school sometime throughout the day, your work should be turned in that same day, if you are on school grounds there is no reason why assignments cannot be turned in on time

School polices will be enforced

Your responsibility to know what you missed and what needs to be turned in (check webpage for clarification)

### Absences – Excused

Students are given two days for each day missed to make up work, and they will receive full credit for make-up work. Example: If you miss a test on an A-day to an excused absence and you return to school the next day, a B-day, you are required to take the test on the next A-day. Students must check with the teachers of the classes they missed on the day they return to school. Work not submitted within the time frame will result in zero (0) credit being earned

### Absences –Unexcused

No credit awarded (test, quiz, paper, and all other assignments)

#### Disciple

- I will follow the student handbook as a guide
- Head down/resting will result in points deducted from CE assignment

#### Cell Phones/Electronic Devices

- NO questions asked, if I SEE it or HEAR it, it will be confiscated

#### Food/Water

- All liquids in a container with a lid
- No FOOD

#### Cheating

- Copying someone else's work is considered cheating; that will also include the person's work which is being copied
- If I catch you copying someone's work in class, both assignments will be taken and thrown away. This goes for any class work.
- Cheating will result in zero points for that assignment

#### Bathroom

- Any request to go to the bathroom or locker will be denied. Come prepared with all class materials; I will not accept any work that is not turned in on time. Medical exceptions require a signed note from parents and the nurse

#### Grades

- 10 day policy, from the time it is posted on JMC (including weekends)
- Have 10 days to change, dispute, or argue a grade that has been entered-remember I do make mistakes
- Please check grades frequently
